


Installation instructions


1. Check the version of the OpenCart store on which you will integrate the expansion module. You can do this from the home page of the administrative panel, the version is written at the bottom of the page.





2. Open the contents of the main directory of the online store and back up the / admin and / catalog directories. You can use an FTP client or other file transfer method for this purpose.
3. Upload the contents of the upload directory (not the directory itself!) To the main directory of the store. When uploading, you may see a message that the admin and catalog directories will be overwritten - confirm the overwrite. This way the new files needed for the module will be added to the current directory content without deleting the other files.



- Open the administration panel of your online store (/ admin) and select from the menu Extensions -> Extensions Installer, click the Upload button and select the file cc_tbiro.ocmod.xml from the installation archive.




5. Then go to Extensions -> Modifications and click the refresh button (small icon in the upper right corner).




6. From the admin panel menu, select Extensions-> Modules.

7. For TBI RO Credit, select Install.



8. After installation, two new links appear in place of Install, select Edit.



9. You can change the settings according to your requirements.
